

Knowledge and Attitude's of School Environment towards Integrating HIV Carriers in Formal Schools

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Abstract

The aim of the study was to determine the Knowledge and attitudes of School Environment (teachers, Parents, Students) towards Integrating HIV \ ADS carriers in formal schools. This study was carried out in Dara Schools. The researcher used tests to measure Knowledge's of (Teacher's, Parent's, Students) And their Attitude's towards integrating HIV \ ADS carriers. of eighth class of basic students. The sample of study was (229) teachers, (361) students, (351) parents. The results of the study were: teachers, parents, and students carried a good level of basic knowledge about (HIV), and most of the sample have a good, and positive Attitudes towards integrating HIV \ ADS carriers in formal schools. The Knowledges and attitude' of students wenemore positive than parents, but the teachers were the best. Regular school based education programmes is recommended to increase awareness of the adolescents towards AIDS.

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
