

The Most Prevalent Leadership Styles among Heads of Administrative Divisions in the Directorate of Education in the Governorate of Damascus Countryside from the Workers' Perspective

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Abstract

The purpose of this study is to figure out the most prevalent leadership styles among administrative heads of divisions in the directorate of education in the governorate of Damascus Countryside from the workers' perspective.

For this purpose, the researcher designed a questionnaire composed of (39) items. Then the researcher applied the questionnaire on the research sample which consisted of (100) workers from the directorate of education in the governorate of Damascus Countryside. After that, the researcher dealt with the results by means of the suitable statistical measurements.

The findings showed the superiority of the relative style since it came in the first place in terms of democratic. The dictator style came second, and the lissy-faire style came last in respect to prevalence among heads of administrative divisions in the directorate of education in the governorate of Damascus Countryside.
