

Personality Types of Damascus University Students according to The Riso–Hadson Scale (The Enneagram System)*

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Abstract

This study aims to recognize the personality types among Damascus University students according to the Riso – Hadson (the Enneagram System). To achieve this goal, the researcher applied the Riso - Hadson Scale which was prepared by the researcher on the Syrian Universities students, on a sample of (400) male and female students from Damascus University students. The results of the study showed the following. The basic personality types of the two faculties. (the Faculty of science and the faculty of Education) was that of the achievement personal type. The second type was of the competitive type.

This means that the tendency to achieve compete and fulfill aims are the qualities that students seem to embody. Based on these findings, the researcher suggests conducting similar studies on other people who belong to different categories of the society.
